NWPL 1962 circa 1900 Royal City High School Over the years many schools known by many names were located on this city block.



NWPL 144 1926 Richard McBride Elementary Built in 1912, burned in 1929, rebuilt in 1929, being replaced right now with a new school.



NWPL 145 Fire February 1929 Richard McBride Elementary



NWPL 1789 Lord Kelvin Elementary

NWPL 3185 circa 1921 F W Howay School (note that this school was known by many different names over the years and it also enlarged over those years. See the school marked Royal City High School. Same building enlarged)



NWPL 2425 circa 1917 Duke of Connaught High School



NWPL 630 circa 1962 This shows Vincent Massey Junior High School and Lester Pearson High School prior to these two schools being united as one that was known as New Westminster Secondary School. A new school is to open in early 2021 on the same site.



NWPL 203 Sapperton School Used 1888 to 1912 when McBride was opened.



NWPL 992 circa 1955 T J Trapp Technical School This was formerly the Provincial Jail but was turned into a technical school when the jail was replaced.



NWPL 18 circa 1908 New Westminster School teachers
