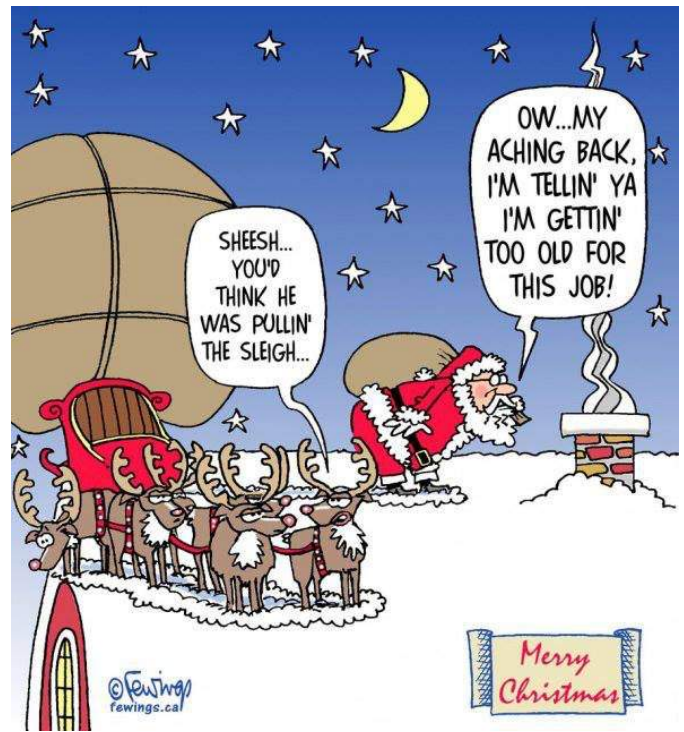
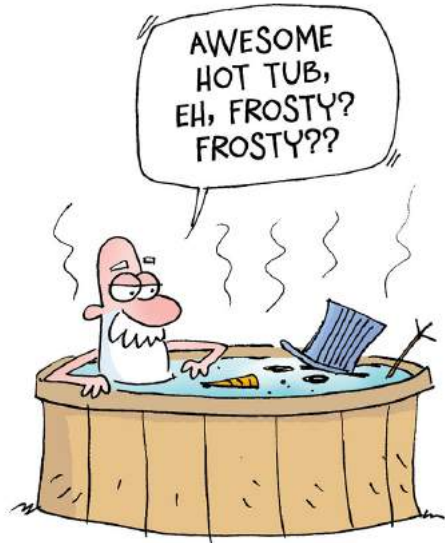
















# Burnaby Village Museum
