What is ORES?

A few years ago the Canada Revenue Agency implemented new rules for Non-Profit organizations with the goal of separating operating funds, which benefit association members, from any charitable donations collected by the association. In accordance with these rules the Oceanside Retired Educators' Scholarship (ORES) was established as a separate organization to manage funds collected for the purpose of conferring annual scholarships to students graduating from Qualicum (S.D. #69) Schools. As a member of the Parksville Qualicum Retired Teachers' Association (PQRTA), you are automatically a member of ORES.

ORES has a small committee (and would welcome more members). We meet regularly to establish goals and evaluate scholarship applications. If you are interested in learning more, or wish to help choose scholarship winners, please contact me. ((<u>cathyvanh@gmail.com</u>)

Have you ever wondered about the R.R. Smith page you see on the last page of every issue of Postscript?

Just like our own Oceanside Retired Educators Scholarship (ORES) is the charitable arm of PQRTA, established to raise monies for local student scholarships, the *R.R. Smith Memorial Fund Foundation* is the charitable arm of the BCRTA. Also similarly, every member of BCRTA automatically becomes a member of the *R.R.* Smith Foundation and pays a small annual fee.

Incorporated and registered as a charity in 2000, the R.R. Smith Memorial Fund Foundation was named in honour of Robert Reid Smith, a founding member of the BC Retired Teachers' Association and Past President of the BCTF. The Foundation provides a focus for the charitable activities of the members of BCRTA. Its reach is broad and extensive and ranges from providing bursaries for low-income students in Surrey to providing sewing machines for young women in Kenya who train to set up a home business as tailors; computer training for children in Uganda; to books for low income children in Guatemala and many more. Applications are received and evaluated every year. In 2023, over \$40,000 in grants to 27 worthy projects were approved. A small but significant fee increase, recently approved at the 2023 AGM, will mean that in 2024 even more projects can be helped. Two local projects that have received monies from R.R. Smith include Tumaini, which supports orphans in Kenya and Eva Hilborn's Wonderful World of Books!
