# Here's an opportunity to support Wonderful World of Books



**DONATE YOUR USED BOOKS** to promote early literacy in preschoolers

In 2021, PQRTA's life member Eva Hilborn founded a registered charity called the **Wonderful World of Books** which gives quality book gifts to local preschoolers.

Each month, 50 volunteers deliver 250 brand new books to the homes of 3 and 4 year olds living in Qualicum School District. After two years, these children have a personal library of 24 books which is a wonderful head start to begin Kindergarten.

You can help promote early literacy skills in young children by donating your used books to the **WWB** account at Fireside Books in Parksville. When a \$1000 credit is reached, the **Wonderful World of Books** will purchase a month's supply of age-appropriate book gifts for preschoolers from Nanoose Bay to Bowser.

- 1. Put used books or jigsaw puzzles into a paper grocery bag or a small liquor store box
- 2. Label with a Post-It note, inside each bag or box: Eva Hilborn WWB 250.752.6217
- 3. During store hours (no appointment needed), drop off to the rack at the cashier desk
  - Used books and/or jigsaw puzzles in gently used condition
  - NO: magazines, readers digest, encyclopedias, DVD's, CD's, VHS, text books, damaged books, ex-library books, or books w/o original dust jacket/cover
  - No plastic bags or bins. Reusable bags are donated to the food bank
  - Credits range from \$1 to \$6 per book or jigsaw puzzle




## **ORES Corner**
